







Tutorial Babymutsje

Requirements:

Stretchable fabric like jersey / tricot / interlock 40 cm in length, the bigger the hat, the more fabric you need in length!

Babybeanie head circumference:

Age: Head circumference:

Premature Smaller than 34 centimeter

0 -1 month 34 centimeter

1 - 2 months 37 centimeter

2 - 4 months 40 centimeter

4 - 6 months 43 centimeter

6 - 9 months 45 centimeter

9 - 12 months 46 centimeter

12 - 18 months 47 centimeter

18 - 24 months 49 centimeter





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In this tutorial I made a newborn beanie, size 0-1 month.
Cut two ovals 38 cm long and 18 cm width. The head circumference is 34 cm, 2x 17cm and 1 cm seam allowence. The fabric is stretchable and the beanie may /must stretch. Use the head circumference and cut 1 extra cm seam allowence. The bigger the beanie, use extra cm



in the width but also in the length!



2. Place the right sides together and stitch around all the way down





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3. Fold in half lengthwise and then widthwise, give a tiny cut, about 1.5 cm, in the middle of the round side..







4. Turn around to the right side through (one of) the hole (s).







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5. Look at the print of the fabric and decide what the outside and the inside of the cap is. The print on the outside must be in the right way. The print of the fabric should be upside down on the inside. (see first image) Fold one side of the inside to the other side so you can put the fabric layers all together trough the hole and pin it.





7. Turn around and you have a baby beanie. Fold the edge and you have a baby hat;







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8. Iron the beanie with or without the fold.
